### **Victim Advocate**

**Duties:** Provide client-directed services to victims of interpersonal violence (domestic abuse, sexual assault) and provide victim advocacy services as needed. Victim advocacy services include: referral, safety planning, assistance with applications for temporary restraining order petitions and crime victim compensation, accompaniment to judicial proceedings, or accompaniment to emergency room or other medical care provider.

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

Bachelor degree in human services, social work, psychology and one year experience (crisis intervention, sociology, human services) leading to working knowledge of family development, advocacy and support services;

OR Associate degree in human services, sociology, or psychology and three years' experience as specified above;

OR High school diploma/GED and five years' experience as specified above.

- Ability to work with a variety of community agencies in obtaining services for clients and improving community response to interpersonal violence. Position also requires an understanding of the dynamics of sexual assault/abuse and/or domestic abuse and the effect on victims.
